Important information



Entrants must assemble on the Recreation Ground in St John's Road no later than **12.45pm**. Judging will start at 1.00pm -

Prizes will be presented immediately following the crowning of the carnival queen at 1.45pm. The procession will move off at **2.15pm**.

The carnival committee hold the street collection licence for carnival day. No other monetary collection for individual charities or persons is permitted during the procession or in its vicinity. Official collection boxes can be obtained from the Carnival marshal prior to the procession starting and must be returned to the marshal's car as you enter Greta Park at the end of the procession.

ADVICE TO ALL THOSE ENTERING VEHICLES IN THE HEDGE END CARNIVAL PROCESSION

1. To avoid tangling with overhead cables do not make your entry over 14ft high.
2. Consider providing safety rails along the side of floats.
3. The use of water sprays, flour or like substances is prohibited.
4. A float captain (submitter of application) must be appointed and named on the entry form to be the point of contact for the carnival organisers.
5. Please have at least one steward walking at either side of the vehicle to ensure the safety of participants and spectators.
6. It is sensible to inform the vehicle insurers that you are taking part in a carnival procession.
7. Your top priority must be the safety of all participants and spectators.

Once you have submitted your entry form that's it, just arrive on the day and have fun ! The organisers will only contact you if there is a problem.
